the original meeting place of Webster Groves Lodge No. 84 (The Old Pettus Home). The original cornerstone was laid by Rabboni Chapter #131 Royal Arch Masons.

Our beautiful building is undergoing much needed renovation that is expected to be completed by its Centennial celebration in 2023. The beautiful memorial brick walkway was completed in the Spring of 2020. Bricks are still available for purchase and are a lovely way to memorialize or honor a loved one.

Throughout the decades our building has accommodated community and civic events as well as meetings, weddings, graduation parties and family gatherings. Our building is home to seven Masonic organizations – one Blue Lodge, one Royal Arch Chapter, one Council of Cryptic Masons, two White Shrines, and two youth organizations – Job's Daughters International for girls 11-21 and DeMolay International for boys 11-21. These organizations support various national and community charities. Our building is also home to Here We Grow a full-time daycare facility housed on our lower level. We also have a recreation room on the lower level for the use of our youth organizations.

Our facility is handicap accessible with an elevator and wheelchair lift at the parking lot entrance. The banquet room, with seating for 200, was recently redecorated with wedding receptions in mind. We have a full kitchen, a parquet dance floor and a stage for the wedding party or the band. These amenities along with VERY reasonable rates make this a prime location for your special day. If your wedding had to be postponed because of Covid-19, or if your venue does not have your chosen date available, we invite you to call us to check our availability and arrange a visit to see if our facilities are right for you. From Interstate 44

From east or west take the Elm Ave. exit.

Turn north on Elm Ave.

Drive north on Elm past Big Bend to Lockwood Ave.

Turn right (east) on Lockwood.

Turn right again into the first driveway on the right. You're There.

From Interstate 64 (U.S. Route 40)

From the east or west take the Brentwood Blvd. exit.

Turn south on Brentwood Blvd.

Continue south on Brentwood Blvd. which becomes Kirkham Rd. and curves to the west.

Continue west on Kirkham Rd. to Elm Ave.

Turn left on Elm and go up the hill to Lockwood Ave.

Turn left (east) on Lockwood.

Turn right into the first driveway on the right. You're There.

From Interstate 170

From the north take the Eager Rd. exit (the southern terminus of Interstate 170).

Turn right on Eager Rd. to Brentwood Blvd.

Turn left (south) on Brentwood Blvd.

Continue south on Brentwood Blvd. which becomes Kirkham Rd. and curves to the west.

Continue west on Kirkham Rd. to Elm Ave.

Turn left on Elm and go up the hill to Lockwood Ave.

Turn left (east) on Lockwood.

Turn right into the first driveway on the right. You're There.
